- safe in your home and anywhere else
- treated with respect
- part of your cultural community



You and your child should be able to:

- participate in your religion
- express your sexuality
- communicate in your family's language



You should be able to:

- make complaints
- say you want to go to another provider



You can tell us what you want and when you want it.



You can tell us what type of worker you want.

You can tell us how you want things done.



We will always try to follow your instructions, unless we feel that your child may get hurt then we will talk to you or your trusted person about the risk.



We agree to follow your wishes and Charter of Rights.
